There are plenty of things that we priests need to be concerned with...but also plenty of things that are not a big deal and that can be changed so that our minds can be occupied with things that matter. Thanks for your patience and understanding!

Indulgences in Honor of Our Lady of Fatima - June 13th As was previously mentioned, there is a special indulgence for pilgrimages to the Fatima shrine in Portugal, but also "to the pious faithful who visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in any [church or chapel] during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions (the 13th of each month, from May to October 2017), and devotedly participate there in any celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Creed, and invoke Our Lady of Fatima." The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence are also required: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

With this in mind, an image of Our Lady of Fatima will be on display on **Tuesday, June 13 at St. Mary in Hamilton. A communal rosary will be prayed at 5:00 p.m.** with the usual Tuesday Mass following. We'd love to have you there!
